Consent for Pupils to Appear in Photographs or in Videos and How They Will Be Used – Academic Year 2026/2027

This form is valid from 1st September 2024 to 31st August 2025. If you have downloaded the SIMS Parent App, you do not need to return this form; you can review Parental Consents in the App. You will be asked to review and update your consent at the start of the next academic year. You can change consent throughout the year either via the SIMS Parent App or by contacting the school office. If you require a paper copy, please contact the school office. We will not use a photograph or video of your child without consent.

Conditions of Use:

- This form is valid from 1st September 2026 to 31st August 2027. If you have downloaded the SIMS Parent App, you do not need to return this form; you can review Parental Consents in the App. You will be asked to review and update your consent at the start of the next academic year. You can change consent throughout the year either via the SIMS Parent App or by contacting the school office.
- The school will not re-use any photographs or recordings of your child that are incompatible with the original purposes explained to you.
- If we use photographs of individual pupils, we will not use the full name of that child in any accompanying text or caption, nor will we include any other personal information
- We may use group or class photographs or footage with very general labels, such as 'a science lesson'.
- We will only use photographs and videos of pupils who are suitably dressed.
- Parents/carers should note that websites can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the United Kingdom, where UK law applies.
